## WEEK IN REVIEW 02/26/2019

"Is spring in the air or not..."? Rotarians were asking themselves as they were greeted by Collier Merrill on their way to buy a raffle ticket from the Auby Smith and yours truly.

President Betty gaveled the meeting to order and following the Prayer and Pledge by Scott Grissett, she commenced with some announcements to include the need for assistance to review community grants, that Business in Ethics nominations are due by the end of March, the District Conference is coming up, and that Ed Wonders is getting prepared for RYLA and can use some help as well.

A whopping \$60 went to the Kathy Horton Brown from the 50/50 raffle. And Dee Dee Flounlacker encouraged all with some Sunshine and recognized our military, two Pensacola Police Officers, and other guests, visiting Rotarians, and birthday boys and girls.

Our program: Doctor Anz is an orthopedic surgeon from the Andrews Institute who is also deep into the research side of cartilage rejuvenation for knees and other joints. In his overview he mentioned that over 38%, or three times that of the general public, of college and professional athletes will suffer from

cartilage damage or other cartilage related issues that are often career ending or lead to debilitating issues later in life. Using grant money, over one million dollars from the State of Florida alone and three million next year, Dr. Anz described the various trials, current five are ongoing, and research underway including "Plasma Rich platelet" therapy. Also, everyone needs to be aware that just because a treatment claims to be using STEM cells that often there is no evidence that they are or that it is a valid treatment. He also mentioned that sometimes not doing anything will lead to recovery from injury as well. Some new processes he discussed included a treatment course from Malaysia that seems to be working well in human trials and that these new efforts to rejuvenate cartilage are a world-wide effort. Additionally, we are very lucky to have the Andrews Research center here as it is really at the tip of the spear when it comes to this type of research as it relates to cartilage generation.

There were a few questions and we adjourned shortly thereafter.
