Leigh began her talk by telling us that the SRIA was formed in 1947 by the Florida Legislature to be the governing body of Pensacola Beach. She said the Board consists of five appointed members and one community leader.

Leigh next gave some facts about the economic impact of tourism bringing in 9.5 million dollars. To her she feels Pensacola Beach is the "biggest free park in Escambia County". During off season, Leigh reported Pensacola Beach does "face lifting" and gave examples such as painting the water tower, renovating pavilions, repairing dune

walkways, parking lot resurfacing, and renovating the "retro Pensacola Beach Sign".

She closed by telling us to get ready for beach events such as Bands on the Beach, Memorial Day Celebration and the Blue Angels Week. A new hotel is in the offering.

President Bruce gave us the history of the day ranging from Slavery, British Parliament and marriage of Bruce and wife Beth.

Scott Grissett was Sunshine and provided humorous notes from his nephew and recognized birthdays.

President Bruce announced it's time to register for the District Conference, the Rotary International Conference, send nominees for Business Ethics, adjourned the meeting and asked all to Imagine Rotary.
