Spring was in the air as Rotarians gathered at the Pensacola Yacht Club for a delightful mix of fellowship and learning. Mark Harden and Lisa York welcomed everyone with a warm smile, and Sherry Hartnett and Hugh Hamilton offered a chance to grab some lucky raffle tickets.

### **Opening Remarks and Announcements**

President Charles kicked off the meeting with the inspiring Four-Way Test. Lisa York then led the group in a moment of meditation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

A round of announcements followed:

- A big thank you to Margaret Stopp for her successful media event promoting the Club's "Beach Buoy" life-saving equipment initiative at Pensacola Beach. The event garnered significant local attention, even featuring on WEAR Channel 3.
- Nominations for the upcoming **Ethics in Business Award** ceremony in early May are now open.

### **Sunshine Report and Guest Speaker**

Stephan Wildish delivered a cheerful Sunshine Report, recognizing birthdays and welcoming guests.

Following the Sunshine Report, Ed Wonders introduced our esteemed guest speaker, Julie Sheppard, Executive Vice President and Legal Counsel for IHMC. Ms. Sheppard, well-known by many Rotarians, has been instrumental in IHMC's journey since its inception at UWF in 2004.

### IHMC: 30 Years of Innovation

Ms. Sheppard provided a captivating overview of IHMC's diverse projects over the past 30 years and ongoing initiatives, including:

- **CMAP software:** This open-source software allows researchers to analyze complex movement data.
- Self-driving car research: IHMC was actively involved in developing and testing autonomous vehicles.
- **Advanced pilot interfaces:** Research focusing on improving pilot interaction with aircraft instruments.
- **Bipedal robots:** Development of robots that can walk and run efficiently.
- **Exoskeleton advancements:** Creating powered exoskeletons to assist individuals with disabilities.

Ms. Sheppard also discussed IHMC's recent endeavors:

- The X-1 exercise machine: Designed for use in space to combat muscle and bone loss experienced by astronauts.
- **Cybersecurity visualization:** Utilizing technology to predict and prevent cyberattacks.
- Voice analysis for disease prediction: Exploring the potential of voice analysis to detect early signs of illness.
- **Educational outreach programs:** Fostering scientific interest and engagement in the younger generation.

Ms. Sheppard expressed her enthusiasm about IHMC's upcoming new downtown facility, which will further support their research into human health and lifespan. Notably, they are also working on a program to reduce the risk of traumatic brain injuries among military personnel during parachute training.

A lively Q&A session followed Ms. Sheppard's presentation, sparking curiosity and further discussion. The meeting adjourned at 1:05 pm.
