The December 7 meeting of the Rotary Club of Pensacola was called to order by President Wonders at 12:05 pm. Participants included 28 members and 2 visitors. Rotarian Verdell Hawkins shared a thoughtful prayer, he spoke of fellowship, grace and productivity.

Program chair, Joe Vinson, welcomed Scott Satterwhite. Scott is the co-author of A Punkhouse in the Deep South, An Oral History of 309. Satterwhite is a historian, writer, educator, and 9-year resident of 309. Scott writes for the IN Weekly and edits the zine Mylxine, which he started in 1995. He's contributed to several publications, including Cometbus, Florida Historical Quarterly, Literature Compass, and Maximum Rock-and-roll. The co-founder of End of the Line Café and the Open Books Prison Book Project, Scott was also in the band Tender Cobra. He holds a Master's Degree in American History and English Literature. His most recent book, A Punkhouse in the Deep South: The Oral History of

309, written with Aaron Cometbus, was released in Fall 2021 by University Press of Florida. He currently teaches writing, rhetoric, composition, and literature at the University of West Florida. He is a veteran of Navy and Marines.

Satterwhite discussed the Communal Life in Pensacola at the Punkhouse located at 309 N. 6th Avenue. He and fellow residents fostered an alternative family life in East Hill. During this period, they helped expand alternative music in Pensacola. Many fellow 309's chose careers in art, education, business and music.

Rotarian Andrea Kreiger, PSC Institutional Development Exec Director introduced students who had received Scholarships funded by the Rotary Club. Each student shared how grateful they were to have received help to finance their education. At JBWES their goal is to elevate lives with services and love.
