President Ed and the visiting District Governor, Larry Kubiak, honored the 5th Paul Harris contribution made by Pensacola Rotarian, Vince Currie. Kubiak and Curry made brief remarks and encouraged members to donate to the Rotary Foundation.

President Wonders' comments celebrated the value of national Drink Beer Day, National Good Neighbor Day, and National Self Care Day. Considering the Rotary jackpot, the joker remains atlarge, and the pot grew to \$176. President Wonders raffled a six pack of beer from Pensacola Bay Brewery. He earned a degree in psychology and began graduate school at the University of Florida. Kubiack later completed a doctorate in counseling psychology which he practiced for 45 years. Kubiack met his wife, Vicki in Live Oak, where we both began our professional careers after college and met at the county fair while she was checking in 4-H projects and I was arranging a booth on the dangers of drinking and driving for the counseling center. They have been married for 42 years and have two children and three grandchildren. In addition to serving as president of the Tallahassee Rotary club he received the club service above self-award in 2012.

District Governor Larry shared with Club Members Goals, Service Projects, Ambassador Roles and to keep the top priority of global eradication of Polio not to come back in the forefront. Each year Rotarians support polio eradication as a Public Health Initiative through donations along with assistance from the Gates Foundation. District Governor Kubiak visits about 50 Clubs and 2600 Rotarians in the 25 Counties of the Northwest Florida Panhandle. He told about a service project in Haiti called Handwash Haiti Project in which Rotarians are providing safe water to drink. That's what Rotary is about... good people improving lives through service in the Community and the World.

President Wonders thanked all involved with running the meeting including the greeter and ticket sales, The meeting adjourned at 1:15 pm.
