Rotary Club Meeting Recap: A Scorching Summer Gathering

The Rotary Club met on a sweltering Tuesday at PYC, with members seeking refuge from the dog days of summer in the air conditioning. Richard Sherrill and Auby Smith greeted attendees, while Auby assisted Pam Smith selling 50/50 raffle tickets.

President Roberts, still reveling in his new title, proudly recognized the Club's 109-year legacy and growing membership of over 160. Benny Jeansonne led the prayer and pledge, followed by Sunshine expert Dale Jordan, who shared election anecdotes and recognized guests, visiting Rotarians, and birthday celebrants.

Pam Smith, a raffle ticket seller, surprisingly won the prize, but the jackpot rolled over to next week, promising over \$1000. Bruce Partington received another Paul Harris Society award for his ongoing support of Rotary International.

Program Highlight: Waterfront Mission Celebrates 75 Years

The program featured Clay Romano, President and CEO of Waterfront Mission, who shared the organization's history and future plans.

Focusing on rescue and recovery for men struggling with addiction, the Mission offers a faith-based curriculum and recently partnered with ARC Gateway to expand their living spaces. Their "day services" provide showers, meals, employment resources, computer access, and clothing, with up to 230 daily visits. Romano highlighted that 40% of local homeless individuals face addiction, and in 2023, the Mission provided 168,000 meals and shelter to thousands. Their seven thrift stores generate 67% of revenues, and they boast an impressive 2.1 million pounds of recycled materials collected last year.

In Other News:

Former President Charles Beall used his discretionary funds (\$5000) to support local arts organizations facing financial challenges, including the Pensacola Symphony and Pensacola Little Theatre.
