WEEK IN REVIEW 10/1/2024

The October 1 meeting of the Rotary Club of Pensacola was held at the Pensacola Yacht Club. President Roberts called the meeting to order at 12:15pm and welcomed approximately 80 members and 4 guests, including Mayor Reeves.

Rotarian Sherrill delivered a thoughtful prayer and led us in the Pledge of Allegiance.

President Roberts guided the group in the Four Way Test and recognized Paul Harris Fellows, Bruce Partington and David Lamar.

President Roberts announced ways members may support victims of Hurricane Helene: (1) members may specify a donation to the local Rotary Club of Pensacola, or (2) contact Marcus Pointe Baptist Church for information regarding their local hurricane relief efforts.

Rotarian Sarah Horne invited the group to participate in Saltmarsh Financial Advisors' Philanthropic Giving event.

Rotarian Betty Roberts welcomed two new members Sophia Forsley and Richard Forsley.

Rotarian Sallis gave members a list of ten negative thoughts to overcome during Sunshine and he recognized 4 guests, including Ross Pristera, Beth Partington, Leigh Davis, and Ben Early.

President Roberts was prompted by members to draw a raffle ticket. Rotarian Pam Smith's ticket was called but sadly, the joker was not present.

Rotarian and chair of the program committee, Olevia McNally,

welcomed Mayor DC Reeves and shared an impressive biography of accomplishments. D.C. Reeves was sworn in as Mayor of his hometown, Pensacola, on Nov. 22, 2022, becoming the youngest person (38) to be elected mayor in 101 years. Reeves spent his professional career as a sports journalist, author, community builder, and entrepreneur.

Mayor discussed a transformative agreement for Pensacola -- a 10-year lease agreement with the team from American Magic, one of the premiere sailing organizations in the world. Pensacola is set to become the team's headquarters as it competes for the oldest trophy in sports, the America's Cup.

Mayor Reeves touted the work of a Community Response Team, tasked with connecting the homeless in our community with available resources. Governor Ron DeSantis appointed D.C. to the CareerSource Florida Board of Directors, which he still serves. In 2024, he was chosen by fellow mayors from across the country to serve on the Advisory Board of the U.S. Conference of Mayors. D.C. is also a member of the Cornerstone Class 42 of Leadership Florida. D.C. believes rest can come when Pensacola is a great place, not just for a few, not just for most, but for all people. The mayor followed his briefing with a Q&A session.

President Roberts thanked all who helped to convene the members and adjourned the meeting at 1:15pm.
