President Henry announced an opportunity for one Rotarian to attend the next Naturalization Ceremony on November 1st.

This week's sunshine was delivered by Past President Charles Beall as only Charles Beall can do. Visitors were recognized and thanked for attending. Birthdays were announced and the crowd sang happy birthday to Past President Paul Tobin. Today's speaker was introduced by Dr. Judy Bense. Dr. Brian Rucker is a seventh generation Santa Rosa County native. He is history professor at Pensacola State College and has written numerous history books about our area and Florida. Today Dr. Rucker spoke regarding the long leaf pine logging industry that began over 300 years ago. The long leaf pine trees averaged 20 feet in diameter and 50 feet tall. Logs were hauled out of the forest by ox and mules. Sawmills were built along waterways in numerous locations of Santa Rosa, Escambia Counties. Without reforestation and conservation within a matter of time the forest was baren of trees. At numerous locations between Pensacola and Tallahassee, long leaf pines have been planted and should be mature in approximately 300 years. Dr. Rucker answered questions and was thanked for his very interesting and informative history lesson regarding our hometown.

President Henry announced next week's speaker Quint Studer who will be speaking about his vision for the future of Pensacola. All who served this week were thanked and the meeting was closed with "The Magic of Rotary".
