In 2013, Niels founded a tech company, Vet CV Mission Next Center, which operates as a secure, digital filling cabinet and vault for medical records and resume information for veterans. One of its unique features is its AI bot embedded in its app to help with communication for those who may not be ready to ask for help from a human. He also founded Vet CV Foundation which has 6 areas of support: 1) Transition, 2) Jobs, 3) Housing, 4) Education, 5) Mental Health and 6) Disaster Relief.
