Guest Speaker: Dr. Troy Shoemaker with Pensacola Christian College (the second president). The school started in 1954 with just 35 students and now

has over 4000 students between the academy (2300 students between K-12) The college does not receive state or federal funding but operates on private funding.

A textbook ministry called Abeka was started by Dr. & Mrs. (Becca) Horton, and it is the world's largest textbooks used by educational institutions in the county, 8-9K as well as thousands of students who are homeschooled.

Pensacola Christian College began in 1974 with only 100 students and today, there are nearly 4000. There are 59 areas of study for the students who attend from across the US and out of the country. Enrollment is slightly down since the pandemic and they are finding that students want to be at home but they are working on how to draw them in. Nursing and Education are among the most sought after in the country.

There are opportunities at the college that businesses, organizations and other entities can collaborate with and if anyone is interested, please contact Dr. Shoemaker.
