

The Blues current aircraft is the Boeing F/A-18 Hornet. Well suited for this mission, it should be their aircraft for many years to come.

The aircraft is serviced by a team of 110 members serving 3-year tours. The pilots and maintenance members are selected by their follow officers or enlisted ranks. The "Boss" is selected by former team leaders. There have been no cancelled shows due to maintenance issues. Members travel 35 weeks per year and they enjoy the time they visiting clubs, schools and organizations in communities. A standing ovation was given for the great job this part of our military does for our country.
